

Greater Flexibility. With all the groups and arrangements that use the Sanctuary, we need a space which can be put together in as many configurations as possible. Expanding the floor and making the pulpit, lectern and Organ movable will create a space that will work for any choir, ensemble or group.

Better Sound. A more open space and moving the pipes to the wall, facing the congregation, will dramatically improve the acoustics and sound presentation of both Sunday Worship, as well as special events and concerts.

Maintaining the Pipe Organ. The bellows, pipes and hoses that make up the Pipe Organ have a limited lifespan. They are now almost 30 years old, and in need of repair.

Preserving the Beauty of the Sanctuary. We all cherish the beauty and majesty of our Worship space, and want to maintain an inspiring look. The proposed design keeps the best parts of the church and, in addition, maintains the style and traditions.

flocess from Iraper flue. Preschool access with a stroller, now requires cutting through the Sanctuary. Installing a ramp on Draper, will allow for easy access to our Children's Wing, as well as to the rear of our Sanctuary.

Hccess from Fellowship Hall. Many young families, who worship at the 10:00am Service, make the dangerous dash through the back ally to reach the Children's Wing. A new entrance will be created from the courtyard allowing children and their parents safe and easy access to the children's wing.

fl Fresh Look and Modern Feel. All of the Preschool classrooms and Sunday School classrooms will be renovated and new classroom furniture will be added as needed. This has not happened in 20 years.

fin Elevator to the Second Floor. An elevator will be added on the south end of the Children's Wing. You will then be able to access the second floor Sunday School classrooms with your strollers.











Courtyard & SunHouse

Knocking Down Barriers. Opening up and connecting the upper and lower courtyard will create a more welcoming space for conversation and community. New furniture and a more open plan will allow for people to be able to see each other across the church campus, and share in life together.

Sit and Relax. The Press, our coffee cart, will move onto the courtyard and our hope is that the courtyard becomes a hub, where people connect and live out the values of caring for one another.

Connecting with SunHouse. We will add wheelchair and stroller accessibility to our SunHouse, which is the area used for our Junior and Senior High Ministries. A bridge will connect the administration building with the SunHouse.

fl Path to the Children's Wing. Expanding the path from the courtyard to the new Children's Wing entrance, will keep our kids safe from alley traffic.
